Green Screen: Climate Fix Flicks is an exciting new short film competition that is now calling for entries. We're looking for creative films that explore ways to alleviate the coming climate crisis such as the positive benefits of moves towards a clean energy future.

Brief

We are seeking film submissions of between 30 seconds and 5 minutes that effectively communicate positive messages about a zero or low carbon, clean energy future. You may choose any genre or style that you like and we encourage participants to push creative boundaries and think outside the square. Green Screen: Climate Fix Flicks is open to everyone.

Judging

Entries will be judged by an expert panel. Judges will include Kimble Rendall (of Matrix and I, Robot movie fame) and Tim Flannery (Chair Climate Change Commission and author of "Here on Earth" and "The Weather Makers") plus well-known scientists, artists & film-makers.
